## RULES FOR THE WORLD MUSKY HUNT <u>GUIDES</u>



- 1. All fishing is to be done according to the rules of the state of Wisconsin.
- 2. All boats must meet U.S. Coast Guard regulations as well as the Wisconsin DNR Boating regulations.
- 3. NO live bait is permitted.
- 4. NO motor trolling is permitted. This includes forward and backward trolling.
- 5. <u>If a guide wears a jacket, hat, or shirt, it must be a World Musky Hunt Item</u>. Guides should wear WMH apparel whenever possible.
- 6. **FISH REGISTRATION:** All fish should be registered by text as soon as possible when they are caught. Send length, angler and guide names, lake, and a picture to Jodi Long @ (920) 740-3828. Collect pins for the angler and guide after fishing hours at the Raymond Sloan Center.
- 7. This event is to promote the area. The decision to keep or release a legal musky is up to the angler who catches it.
- 8. Winners will be determined by the total number of inches of legal muskies caught. (34 inch minimum) If the angler releases the musky more than one can be caught per day. The legal limit is one musky per day kept.
- 9. A Sportsmanship trophy, outstanding act that occurred during the hunt, and a dead fish trophy, (biggest screw up) are presented each year. Please be aware of incidents which may qualify a person for either award. A summary of the situation should be turned in with your reports. If you have a camera please include pictures.
- 10. All contestants must fish the waters of the Minocqua chain of lakes, on Friday, on Saturday it will be up to the guide where they fish.
- 11. Past hunters are allowed to fish other lakes.
- 12. Fishing during the World Musky Hunt will be done on publicly accessible lakes. For this organization the definition of "publicly accessible" means open to the public and are controlled by State, County, or Municipal organization.
- 13. Guides will <u>ensure</u> that contestants arrive on time for the shore lunches and other official functions. (CONTESTANTS SHOULD BE AT ALL MEALS.)
- 14. Please refrain from the use of abusive and foul language in the presence of our guests. Remember our task is to make our guests feel welcome and have an enjoyable time during the hunt.
- 15. It is mandatory for everyone to return on Friday for the shore lunch. If you do not return for shore lunch all fish caught that day will not count. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>. Any questions regarding these rule's contact: Jerry Driessen, Mike Driessen, or Isaac Laube.
